

Decatur County Open Class Horse Show Registration

Saturday, July 29, 2023

1. See General Rules in the Decatur County Fair Book.
2. All 4-H/FFA horses will be ID'ed at entry time (for 4-H Show).
3. No stallions are eligible to be shown.
4. The Horse Show will be governed by the Kansas 4-H Horse Show Rule book (S-37).
5. Horses shall be entered at 8:00 a.m. the day of the show. Pre-entry is encouraged. All animals are dismissed after the show has concluded.
6. A negative Coggins test and valid health certificate is encouraged but not required.
7. Classes may be added to the show at the discretion of the superintendents.
8. The use of protective headgear, in place of a hat, is the optional choice of the exhibitor in any and all western classes, including judged and timed classes.
9. High Point will be calculated for each age division with top placing receiving points equal to the number of entries in that class and age division.
