Rule 4. Candidates must complete this application and a one page essay stating why they want to be 4-H King or Queen, what they have achieved in 4-H, and/or what 4-H means to them. This must be submitted to the Extension Office on or before the Friday prior to the Style Revue and Clothing Judging.

Rule 5. Candidates must show proof of any public service/community service project completed in the past year that benefits 4-H.

Rule 6. The new 4-H King and Queen will emcee the annual Appreciation/Achievement Banquet.

Rule 7. Candidates must be present at the 4-H Public Style Revue to be interviewed and to receive awards.

Rule 8. Previous 4-H King and Queen winners are allowed to run again as long as they are not running in a consecutive year after winning.

Rule 9. 4-H King and Queen winners and runners-up will each be required to perform a community service project and must present proof to 4-H Council before next year's fair.

Rule 10. 4-H King and Queen winners will each receive \$50 and each runner-up will receive \$25 after the required community service projects are completed. Prizes are provided by Sheridan County Fair Board and Sheridan County 4-H Council and winners of these awards are encouraged to send thank you cards.
