CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

RUTH EMILY MCRAE/4-H COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility:

Any High School graduated senior or college level student between the ages of 17 and 24 who has completed at least 3 years of 4-H club work in Graham County is eligible to apply for the Ruth Emily McRae/4-H Council scholarship. If the selection committee feels that no applicant is deserving of the scholarship, it will not be awarded.

Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the college/university in which student is enrolled, **after** the recipient is officially enrolled.

One hundred (100) points possible will be earned in the following manner:

30 points from application form and letter of application40 points from personal interview30 points from Permanent Record

The letter of application should include such items as:

- 1. what you have gained from 4-H,
- 2. career plans,
- 3. why you feel you deserve the scholarship, and
- 4. any other information which communicates your qualifications for the scholarship.

The selection committee will be formed in the following manner:

- 1. One person will represent each of the three Commissioner Districts in the county. They will be selected by PDC members who represent the District or the Extension Agent.
- 2. One person selected at large from the school systems within the county.
- 3. One person selected at large representing the business community within the county.
